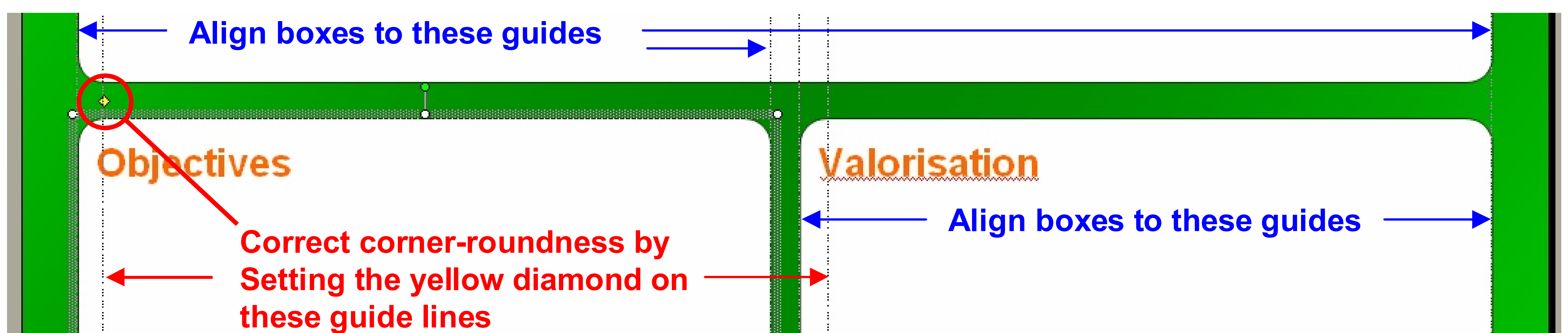




Poster Instructions & Guidelines

- Use the provided powerpoint template to build your poster
- Please keep layout (background, colors, font colors and sizes) as provided. Headers are orange and normal text is dark green (as in template, RGB values provided).
- The top box (containing logo and poster title) may *not* be altered, other boxes may be resized to any height and may span one or two columns. Boxes may be added (just copy another) or deleted as long as these headers are used: Research Team, Background, Objectives, Approach, and Valorisation. A box with Innovation is optional.
- Please display Drawing Guides [*hulplijnen*] through the powerpoint menu – Display [*Beeld*].
- Keep boxes aligned to these (dashed) guides, as in the template (top, bottom, right, left). See also [example](#) below.
- The roundness/size/radius of the rounded corners of the boxes will change as soon as the box is resized. To keep roundness of all corners the same, click on the border of the resized box and shift the yellow diamond exactly on the dashed guide line as in the [example](#) below.



- Figures or pictures may be placed inside the boxes.
- When ready, use any software application to produce a PDF file of your poster. PDF XChange is freely available on the UM software website. Be sure to set the page size to A0 portrait in the printer settings (with PDF XChange also set Layout format to A0).
- Carefully review the PDF file before sending to us. We will take care of printing the poster.
